## AN ACT

Amending the act of September 30, 1985 (P.L.240, No.61), 2 entitled "An act to facilitate vehicular traffic within and 3 across the Commonwealth by providing for the construction, reconstruction, improvement, operation and maintenance of toll roads and the conversion of existing toll-free roads to 6 toll roads in Pennsylvania; conferring powers and imposing 7 duties on the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission; providing for membership on the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission; 9 authorizing issuance of turnpike revenue bonds, notes or other obligations of the commission, payable solely from 10 revenues of the commission, including tolls, or from such 11 12 other funds as may be available to the commission for that 13 purpose, to pay the costs of such toll roads including the 14 acquisition and other costs of toll-free roads and for 15 refunding purposes; providing that no debt of the 16 Commonwealth shall be incurred in the exercise of any of the powers granted by this act; providing for the collection of 17 18 tolls for the payment of such bonds, notes or other 19 obligations, and for the cost of maintenance, operation and 20 repair of the toll roads including toll-free roads converted 21 to toll roads; making such turnpike revenue bonds, notes or 22 other obligations exempt from taxation; constituting the same 23 legal investments in certain instances; requiring suits 24 against the commission to be brought in the courts in which 25 such actions may be brought against the Commonwealth; prescribing conditions on which toll roads shall be turned 26 27 over to the Department of Transportation; providing for grade separations, grade changes, relocations, restorations and 28 vacations of public roads and State highways affected by the 29

- toll roads; providing for the purchasing or condemnation of 1 2 land and procedure for determining damages in condemnation; 3 granting certain powers and authority to municipalities and 4 agencies of the Commonwealth to cooperate with the 5 commission; conferring powers and imposing duties on the Department of Transportation; authorizing the Secretary of 6 7 Transportation to enter into negotiations with the United 8 States Department of Transportation, the Federal Highway 9 Administration or any other Federal agency regarding the 10 conversion of toll-free highways constructed in the Commonwealth using Federal funds to toll roads; and 11 12 authorizing the Secretary of Transportation to enter into 13 agreements on behalf of the Commonwealth and the commission 14 with the United States Department of Transportation, the 15 Federal Highway Administration or any other Federal agency with respect to obtaining Federal funds for resurfacing, 16 restoring, rehabilitating or reconstructing toll roads in 17 Pennsylvania, providing for decals or stickers evidencing 18 19 the prepayment of tolls.
- 20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 21 hereby enacts as follows:
- 22 Section 1. The act of September 30, 1985 (P.L.240, No.61),
- 23 known as the Turnpike Organization, Extension and Toll Road
- 24 Conversion Act, is amended by adding a section to read:
- 25 Section 16.1. Decals or stickers evidencing prepayment of
- 26 <u>tolls.</u>
- The commission shall, on a monthly basis, make available for
- 28 purchase by persons who regularly travel the same route on the
- 29 turnpike, a decal or sticker evidencing prepayment of the
- 30 appropriate tolls. The commission shall set aside a lane or
- 31 lanes at exchanges of the turnpike to provide for the
- 32 expeditious exit of vehicles displaying the decal or sticker.
- 33 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
