AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, further providing for the maintenance of certain  
3 information on surrendered registrations and licenses.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Sections 1376 and 1540 of Title 75 of the  
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended by adding  
8 subsections to read:

9 § 1376. Surrender of registration plates and cards upon  
10 suspension or revocation.

12 (a.1) Record and receipt of surrendered registration plates  
13 and cards.--Whenever a member of the Pennsylvania State Police  
14 or a local police officer seizes a suspended registration plate

1 or card, the substation or municipal police office shall issue a  
2 receipt which contains and shall maintain on record all of the  
3 following information:

4       (1) The name, address and telephone number of the person  
5 affected by the surrender or seizure.

6       (2) The date the item was surrendered or seized which  
7 date shall also be construed to be the date of receipt by the  
8 department.

9       (3) The item which was surrendered or seized.

10       (4) The name of the officer or employee effecting the  
11 surrender or seizure.

12       (5) The date the item was transmitted to the department  
13 which date shall be within three days of the date under  
14 paragraph (2).

16 § 1540. Surrender of license.

18       (d) Record and receipt of surrendered license.--Whenever a  
19 member of the Pennsylvania State Police or a local police  
20 officer seizes a suspended license, the substation or municipal  
21 police office shall issue a receipt which contains and shall  
22 maintain on record all of the following information:

23       (1) The name, address and telephone number of the person  
24 affected by the surrender or seizure.

25       (2) The date the item was surrendered or seized which  
26 date shall also be construed to be the date of receipt by the  
27 department.

28       (3) The item which was surrendered or seized.

29       (4) The name of the officer or employee effecting the  
30 surrender or seizure.

1           (5) The date the item was transmitted to the department  
2           which date shall be within three days of the date under  
3           paragraph (2).  
4           Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
