AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 18, 1984 (P.L.263, No.62), entitled "A
2 supplement to the act of (P.L. , No.), entitled 'An act
3 providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1983-
4 1984,' itemizing public improvement projects, furniture and
5 equipment projects, redevelopment assistance projects and
6 transportation assistance projects to be constructed or
7 acquired or assisted by the Department of General Services,
8 the Department of Transportation, the Department of Community
9 Affairs or the Pennsylvania Fish Commission, together with
10 their estimated financial cost; authorizing the incurring of
11 debt without the approval of the electors for the purpose of
12 financing the projects to be constructed or acquired or
13 assisted by the Department of General Services, the
14 Department of Transportation or the Department of Community
15 Affairs; stating the estimated useful life of the projects;
16 authorizing issuing officials to undertake limited temporary
17 borrowing through negotiated settlements; and making an
18 appropriation," increasing funds for a National Guard armory
19 project.

20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

21 hereby enacts as follows:

22 Section 1. Sections 1(a) and 2(9) of the act of May 18, 1984
23 (P.L.263, No.62), entitled "A supplement to the act of (P.L.
24 , No.), entitled 'An act providing for the capital budget for
25 the fiscal year 1983-1984,' itemizing public improvement
26 projects, furniture and equipment projects, redevelopment

1 assistance projects and transportation assistance projects to be
2 constructed or acquired or assisted by the Department of General
3 Services, the Department of Transportation, the Department of
4 Community Affairs or the Pennsylvania Fish Commission, together
5 with their estimated financial cost; authorizing the incurring
6 of debt without the approval of the electors for the purpose of
7 financing the projects to be constructed or acquired or assisted
8 by the Department of General Services, the Department of
9 Transportation or the Department of Community Affairs; stating
10 the estimated useful life of the projects; authorizing issuing
11 officials to undertake limited temporary borrowing through
12 negotiated settlements; and making an appropriation," are
13 amended to read:

14 Section 1. Total authorizations.

15 (a) The total authorization for the additional capital
16 projects in the category of public improvement projects itemized
17 in section 2 and to be acquired or constructed by the Department
18 of General Services, its successors or assigns, and to be
19 financed by the incurring of debt, shall be [\$633,121,000]
20 \$633,870,000.

26 Section 2. Section 12(a), vetoed in part, is amended
 27 to read:

28 Section 12. Appropriations.

29 (a) The net proceeds of the sale of the obligations herein
 30 authorized are hereby appropriated from the Capital Facilities

1 Fund to the Department of General Services in the maximum amount
2 of [\$310,907,000] \$311,656,000 to be used by it exclusively to
3 defray the financial cost of the public improvement projects
4 specifically itemized in a capital budget. After reserving or
5 paying the expenses of the sale of the obligation, the State
6 Treasurer shall pay to the Department of General Services the
7 moneys as required and certified by it to be legally due and
8 payable.

10 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
