10	§ 1532. Revocation or suspension of operating privilege.
11	(a) RevocationThe department shall revoke the operating
12	privilege of any driver for one year upon receiving a certified
13	record of the driver's conviction of or an adjudication of
14	delinquency based on any of the following offenses:

16	(2) Any violation of section 3735 (relating to homicide
17	by vehicle while driving under influence). <u>If the driver is</u>
18	sentenced to imprisonment as a result of the violation, the

1 <u>one-year period shall not begin until the driver is released</u>
2 <u>from imprisonment.</u>

6 (3) The department shall suspend the operating privilege 7 of any driver for 12 months upon receiving a certified record of the driver's conviction of section 3731 (relating to 8 9 driving under influence of alcohol or controlled substance) or an adjudication of delinquency based on section 3731. If 10 11 the driver is sentenced to imprisonment as a result of the conviction or adjudication, the 12-month period shall not 12 13 begin until the driver is released from imprisonment. The department shall suspend the operating privilege of any 14 15 driver for six months upon receiving a certified record of a 16 consent decree granted under 42 Pa.C.S. Ch. 63 (relating to 17 juvenile matters) based on section 3731.

22 (b) Suspension for refusal.--

23 If any person placed under arrest for a violation of (1)24 section 3731 (relating to driving under influence of alcohol 25 or controlled substance) is requested to submit to chemical 26 testing and refuses to do so, the testing shall not be 27 conducted but upon notice by the police officer, the 28 department shall suspend the operating privilege of the 29 person for a period of 12 months. Any time that the person is imprisoned under sentence imposed for the violation for which 30 - 2 -19910H2048B2554

- 1 the person was arrested shall not be counted as part of the 2 <u>12-month period.</u> * * * 3 4 Section 2. The amendments of 75 Pa.C.S. §§ 1532(a)(2) and
- 5 (b)(3) and 1547(b)(1) shall apply to violations which occur on 6 or after the effective date of this act.
- Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 7
