AN ACT

1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for an
3 additional district justice having county-wide jurisdiction
4 in certain counties.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 1511 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

9 § 1511. District justices.

10 (a) General rule.--There shall be one district justice in
11 each magisterial district.

12 (b) Additional district justices.--In addition to the
13 district justices provided for in subsection (a), each county
14 having ten or more magisterial districts shall have one
15 additional district justice to be elected from the registered
16 electors of the county. This additional district justice shall
17 have county-wide jurisdiction and shall sit at times and
18 locations as the president judge of the judicial district shall

1 direct.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
