13	or removed from office may, with his consent, be assigned on

15	senior district justice who has been defeated for reelection
16	shall be eligible for assignment pursuant to this section. A
17	senior district justice shall be paid a per diem salary at the
18	same annual rate as is applicable in the district where he is
