## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 27, 1955 (P.L.744, No.222), 2 entitled, as amended, "An act prohibiting certain practices 3 of discrimination because of race, color, religious creed, ancestry, age or national origin by employers, employment 5 agencies, labor organizations and others as herein defined; 6 creating the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission in the 7 Department of Labor and Industry; defining its functions, 8 powers and duties; providing for procedure and enforcement; providing for formulation of an educational program to 9 prevent prejudice; providing for judicial review and 10 11 enforcement and imposing penalties, "further providing for 12 unlawful discriminatory practices. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 5 of the act of October 27, 1955 16 (P.L.744, No.222), known as the Pennsylvania Human Relations 17 Act, is amended by adding a clause to read: 18 Section 5. Unlawful Discriminatory Practices .-- It shall be 19 an unlawful discriminatory practice, unless based upon a bona 20 fide occupational qualification, or in the case of a fraternal corporation or association, unless based upon membership in such 21 22 association or corporation, or except where based upon

- 2 or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

- 4 (1) For any employer to refuse to hire or to discharge any
- 5 <u>individual</u>, or otherwise disadvantage any individual, with
- 6 <u>respect to compensation or terms, conditions or privileges of</u>
- 7 <u>employment because the individual engages in lawful activities</u>
- 8 or uses lawful products off the premises of the employer during
- 9 <u>nonworking hours.</u>

- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
