AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for Class C licenses.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 1504(d)(3) of Title 75 of the
- 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 1504. Classes of licenses.
- 8 * * *
- 9 (d) Number and description of classes.--Licenses issued by
- 10 the department shall be classified in the following manner:
- 11 * * *
- 12 (3) Class C.--A Class C license shall be issued to those
- persons 18 years of age or older, except as provided in
- section 1503 (relating to persons ineligible for licensing),

- who have demonstrated their qualifications to operate any single vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating of not more than 26,000 pounds or any such vehicle towing a vehicle if the gross combination vehicle weight rating is not more than 26,000 pounds.
 - (i) Where required under this title, appropriate endorsements must be obtained.
 - (ii) Any firefighter who is the holder of a Class C license and who has a certificate of authorization from his fire chief shall be authorized to operate any fire or emergency vehicle registered to the fire department, regardless of the other requirements of this section as to the class of license required. The issuing fire chief shall retain the certificate of authorization. No fire chief, fire department, including any volunteer fire company, or municipality shall be liable for any civil damages as a result of the issuance of a certificate authorized under this paragraph unless such act constituted a crime, actual fraud, actual malice or willful misconduct.
 - (iii) The holder of a Class C license shall also be authorized to drive a motorized pedalcycle or a three-wheeled motorcycle equipped with an enclosed cab, but not a motorcycle unless the license is endorsed, as provided in this title.
