AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, conferring certain duties on the insurer.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 1786(e)(2) of Title 75 of the
- 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 1786. Required financial responsibility.

- 9 (e) Obligations upon termination of financial
- 10 responsibility.--
- 11 * * *
- 12 (2) An insurer who has issued a contract of motor
- 13 vehicle liability insurance, or any approved self-insurance
- 14 entity, shall notify the department in a timely manner and in

- a method prescribed by the department's regulations. <u>Further</u>,
- 2 <u>it is the responsibility of the insurer to notify the vehicle</u>
- 3 <u>owner in writing that State law requires that the</u>
- 4 <u>registration and license plates of the vehicle be surrendered</u>
- 5 to the department at the time the insurance coverage is
- 6 <u>terminated or financial responsibility lapsed.</u>

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
