AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to the Museum of the Philadelphia Civic
- 2 Center for maintenance and the purchase of apparatus,
- 3 supplies and equipment.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The sum of \$176,000 is hereby appropriated to the
- 7 Museum of the Philadelphia Civic Center, Philadelphia, for the
- 8 fiscal year July 1, 1992, to June 30, 1993, for maintenance and
- 9 the purchase of apparatus, supplies and equipment.
- 10 Section 2. Payments to the Museum of the Philadelphia Civic
- 11 Center on account of the appropriation provided in section 1
- 12 shall be made quarterly by the Executive Director of the
- 13 Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission.
- 14 Section 3. The Museum of the Philadelphia Civic Center shall
- 15 provide full, complete and accurate information as may be
- 16 required by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission or
- 17 the Majority Chairman or the Minority Chairman of the
- 18 Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the Majority Chairman

- 1 or the Minority Chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the
- 2 House of Representatives.
- 3 Section 4. No funds from an appropriation made by this act
- 4 shall be made available for expenditure after October 1, 1992,
- 5 unless a good faith effort, as prescribed by the Department of
- 6 Public Welfare, has been made to hire welfare clients for new
- 7 jobs created as a result of the State appropriations. No
- 8 existing employees or employees on unemployment compensation are
- 9 to be displaced by this effort. A report detailing these efforts
- 10 is to be submitted to the Department of Public Welfare by
- 11 September 15, 1992. The Department of Public Welfare shall give
- 12 written notification of compliance to the State Treasurer.
- 13 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1992, or
- 14 immediately, whichever is later.
