A RESOLUTION

1 Urging the President of The Pennsylvania State University to
2 take such action as is necessary to continue the tradition of
3 intrastate football rivalry between Penn State and Pitt.

4 WHEREAS, For nearly a century, The Pennsylvania State
5 University and the University of Pittsburgh have enjoyed a long
6 tradition of meeting each other on the gridiron; and

7 WHEREAS, The football series between these two great
8 Pennsylvania universities has been uninterrupted for nearly 60
9 years; and

10 WHEREAS, This friendly, traditional athletic rivalry has
11 provided the student body and the alumni of both universities as
12 well as the residents of this Commonwealth with immeasurable
13 enjoyment; and

14 WHEREAS, This traditional football rivalry is scheduled to
15 conclude on November 21, 1992, when the two great Pennsylvania
16 football teams will meet each other for the last time at Beaver

1 Stadium; therefore be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge Penn State
3 President Joab Thomas to take such action as is necessary to
4 enable these two great Pennsylvania universities to continue
5 their nearly century-old gridiron rivalry for the benefit of
6 their students, alumni, fans and all the residents of this
7 Commonwealth; and be it further

8 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be delivered to Penn
9 State President Joab Thomas, and to all the members of the Board
10 of Trustees of The Pennsylvania State University.
