## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commemorating "Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day."
- WHEREAS, December 7, 1991, marks the 50th Anniversary of the
- 3 Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Over 2400 military and civilian lives were lost
- 5 during the 110-minute attack on the morning of December 7, 1941;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, The people of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and
- 8 the nation recognize the bravery of those who lost their lives
- 9 or suffered injuries on that day of infamy; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorate
- 11 December 7, 1991, as "Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day"; and be it
- 12 further
- 13 RESOLVED, That local governments and communities throughout
- 14 this Commonwealth be encouraged to conduct appropriate
- 15 observances of "Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day."
