A RESOLUTION

1 Commemorating "Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day."

2 WHEREAS, December 7, 1991, marks the 50th Anniversary of the
3 Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor; and

4 WHEREAS, Over 2400 military and civilian lives were lost
5 during the 110-minute attack on the morning of December 7, 1941;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, The people of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and
8 the nation recognize the bravery of those who lost their lives
9 or suffered injuries on that day of infamy; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorate
11 December 7, 1991, as "Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day"; and be it
12 further

13 RESOLVED, That local governments and communities throughout
14 this Commonwealth be encouraged to conduct appropriate
15 observances of "Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day."
