A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of September 20 through 26, 1992, as
2 "National Adult Day Care Center Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, There are over 2,100 adult day care centers
4 nationwide, some of which serve adults starting at 18 years of
5 age and others which serve primarily senior citizens, providing
6 a safe and positive environment to partially disabled
7 individuals in need of daytime assistance and supervision; and

8 WHEREAS, Adult day care centers provide necessary health
9 maintenance functions and medical care, including medication
10 monitoring, therapies and health education. The centers are
11 operated by professional staff who identify the need for
12 additional health services and make appropriate referrals; and

13 WHEREAS, Adult day care centers provide opportunities for
14 social interactions to otherwise isolated individuals and assist
15 them in attaining and maintaining a maximum level of
16 independence; and

17 WHEREAS, These centers offer relief to families who otherwise

1 must care for disabled elderly persons on a 24-hour per day
2 basis; therefore be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
4 week of September 20 through 26, 1992, as "National Adult Day
5 Care Center Week" in Pennsylvania.
