A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of September 20 through 26, 1992, as 2
 - "National Adult Day Care Center Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, There are over 2,100 adult day care centers
- 4 nationwide, some of which serve adults starting at 18 years of
- 5 age and others which serve primarily senior citizens, providing
- a safe and positive environment to partially disabled 6
- 7 individuals in need of daytime assistance and supervision; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Adult day care centers provide necessary health
- maintenance functions and medical care, including medication
- 10 monitoring, therapies and health education. The centers are
- operated by professional staff who identify the need for 11
- additional health services and make appropriate referrals; and 12
- 13 WHEREAS, Adult day care centers provide opportunities for
- 14 social interactions to otherwise isolated individuals and assist
- 15 them in attaining and maintaining a maximum level of
- 16 independence; and
- WHEREAS, These centers offer relief to families who otherwise 17

- 1 must care for disabled elderly persons on a 24-hour per day
- 2 basis; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 3
- 4 week of September 20 through 26, 1992, as "National Adult Day
- 5 Care Center Week" in Pennsylvania.
