A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
2 of Pennsylvania, further providing for terms of members of
3 the General Assembly.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby resolves as follows:

6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:

8 That section 3 of Article II be amended to read:

9 § 3. Terms of members.

10 Senators shall be elected for the term of [four] six years
11 and Representatives for the term of [two] four years.

12 Section 2. At the first general election at which a Governor
13 is elected after the adoption of this amendment, and every six
14 years thereafter in the case of Senators, and every four years
15 thereafter in the case of Representatives, Senators shall be
16 elected for terms of six years and Representatives shall be
17 elected for terms of four years.
