AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for reimbursement to volunteer fire
- 3 companies that remove vehicles and spilled cargo from
- 4 roadways.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 7310 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 7310. Removal of vehicles and spilled cargo from roadway.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (d) Costs of removal. -- Volunteer fire companies that respond
- 12 to vehicle accidents or cargo spills shall, upon determination
- 13 of liability against a responsible party, submit a bill to the
- 14 insurer of the responsible party or, if self-insured, to the
- 15 responsible party, and shall be reimbursed for costs of

- 1 responding to and for materials used in connection with removal
- 2 and cleanup of property and debris.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
