## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto, "further providing for establishment
- 6 and maintenance of consolidated schools.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 505 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 10 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, amended October
- 11 21, 1965 (P.L.601, No.312), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 505. Establishment and Maintenance of Consolidated
- 13 Schools. -- The board of directors of any school district may.
- 14 after consent of the electors of the school district is obtained
- 15 by referendum, establish, equip, furnish, and maintain
- 16 consolidated schools formed by uniting two or more public
- 17 schools, which prior to such union were maintained in separate
- 18 buildings, and after such union are maintained in one school
- 19 organization taught by two or more teachers. The board of school

- 1 directors may transport pupils to and from such schools as
- 2 provided for by this act.
- Section 2. The amendment of section 505 of the act shall 3
- 4 apply to school years beginning on or after the effective date
- 5 of this act.
- Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
