## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 commissions shall be determined, "further providing for the 21 Pennsylvania State Police Force.
- 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 205(a) and (b) of the act of April 9,
- 25 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of
- 26 1929, amended July 25, 1963 (P.L.278, No.148) and July 11, 1991

- 1 (P.L.73, No.12), are amended to read:
- 2 Section 205. Pennsylvania State Police.--(a) The
- 3 Pennsylvania State Police shall consist of a Commissioner, a
- 4 Deputy Commissioner, the State police force, and the State
- 5 Highway Patrol, as now authorized by law, which are hereby
- 6 consolidated into one force, to be known as the State Police
- 7 Force, and such chiefs, statisticians, clerks, experts and other
- 8 assistants or any support staff necessary to assist in
- 9 <u>completing the administrative duties currently falling upon the</u>
- 10 State Police officers, as the commissioner, with the approval of
- 11 the Governor, shall deem necessary for the work of the force.
- 12 (b) The State Police Force shall consist of such number of
- 13 officers and men, and shall be organized in such manner, as the
- 14 Commissioner of Pennsylvania State Police, with the approval of
- 15 the Governor, shall from time to time determine: Provided,
- 16 however, That the number of officers and men shall not exceed in
- 17 the aggregate at any time three thousand nine hundred and forty
- 18 persons. State policemen, both officers and men, assigned to
- 19 duty with the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission or assigned to
- 20 duty as resident State troopers and civilians performing
- 21 <u>administrative duties</u>, shall not be counted in determining the
- 22 total number of officers and men in the State Police Force.

- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
