AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 20 commissions shall be determined, "providing for academic 21 course credit for community service.

- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- 24 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 25 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a
- 26 section to read:

- 1 Section 1321. Academic Course Credit for Community
- 2 <u>Service.--(a)</u> The State Board of Education shall create and
- 3 promulgate by regulation a program offering academic course
- 4 <u>credit for students at State colleges and universities who</u>
- 5 perform volunteer community service work.
- 6 (b) As used in this section, the term "State college and
- 7 <u>university" means the State-owned and State-related universities</u>
- 8 and member institutions of the State System of Higher Education.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
