## INTRODUCED BY CAWLEY, MARCH 15, 1993

### REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON CONSERVATION, MARCH 15, 1993

#### AN ACT

1	Amending the act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), entitled "An
2	act providing for the planning and regulation of solid waste
3	storage, collection, transportation, processing, treatment,
4	and disposal; requiring municipalities to submit plans for
5	municipal waste management systems in their jurisdictions;
б	authorizing grants to municipalities; providing regulation of
7	the management of municipal, residual and hazardous waste;
8	requiring permits for operating hazardous waste and solid
9	waste storage, processing, treatment, and disposal
10	facilities; and licenses for transportation of hazardous
11	waste; imposing duties on persons and municipalities;
12	granting powers to municipalities; authorizing the
13	Environmental Quality Board and the Department of
14	Environmental Resources to adopt rules, regulations,
15	standards and procedures; granting powers to and imposing
-	
16	duties upon county health departments; providing remedies;
17	prescribing penalties; and establishing a fund," further
18	providing for the disposal, processing and storage of
19	municipal waste.

- 20 The General Assembly finds as follows:
- 21 (1) The Commonwealth needs to insure that waste disposal
- 22 sites can be properly monitored and controlled.
- 23 (2) The Commonwealth needs to minimize the
- 24 environmental, economic, social and aesthetic impact of waste
- 25 disposal sites on surrounding communities.
- 26 (3) The Commonwealth needs to prevent the construction

of massive sites in one location in order to minimize local 1 2 negative impact and to facilitate effective monitoring 3 programs and, when necessary, practical remediation and 4 control programs. 5 (4) The Commonwealth needs to insure disposal capacity for waste generated within its borders. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), known 9 as the Solid Waste Management Act, is amended by adding a 10 11 section to read: Section 204. Disposal, processing and storage of municipal 12 13 <u>waste.</u> It shall be unlawful for any person or municipality who 14 stores, processes or disposes of municipal waste: 15 16 (1) to create or operate a disposal site on more than 17 100 contiguous acres; 18 (2) to locate or operate a disposal site within 5,000 19 feet of another disposal site; 20 (3) to create or operate a disposal site which exceeds the elevation of adjacent land by more than 50 feet; 21 (4) to create or operate a disposal site which will have 22 23 a depth of more than 100 feet of waste; or 2.4 (5) to accept more than 2,000 tons of waste per day. 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
