AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled 1 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, primary and election expenses and election contests; creating 4 5 and defining membership of county boards of elections; 6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 7 8 9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 10 11 elections," further providing for false signatures and statements in nomination petitions and papers and for 12 nomination petitions. 13

14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

15 hereby enacts as follows:

16 Section 1. Sections 1813 and 1814 of the act of June 3, 1937

17 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, are

18 amended to read:

Section 1813. False Signatures and Statements in Nomination Petitions and Papers.--If any person shall knowingly make a false statement in any affidavit required by the provisions of this act, to be appended to or to accompany a nomination

petition or a nomination paper, or if any person shall 1 2 fraudulently sign any name not his own to any nomination 3 petition or nomination paper, or if any person shall 4 fraudulently alter any nomination petition or nomination paper 5 without the consent of the signers, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to 6 7 pay a fine not exceeding five hundred (\$500) dollars, or to undergo imprisonment of not more than one (1) year, or both, in 8 9 the discretion of the court. Such person shall not be permitted to participate as a candidate in a public election in this 10 11 Commonwealth until all costs and fines resulting from violation 12 of this act SECTION have been paid in full.

13 Section 1814. Nomination Petitions; Certificates and Papers; 14 Destruction; Fraudulent Filing; Suppression. -- Any person who 15 shall falsely make any nomination certificate or who shall 16 wilfully deface or destroy any nomination petition, nomination 17 certificate or nomination paper, or any part thereof, or any 18 letter of withdrawal, or who shall file any nomination petition, nomination certificate or nomination paper or letter of 19 20 withdrawal knowing the same, or any part thereof, to be falsely 21 made, or who shall suppress any nomination petition, nomination 22 certificate or nomination paper, or any part thereof, which has 23 been duly filed, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon 24 conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine not 25 exceeding one thousand (\$1,000) dollars, or to undergo an 26 imprisonment of not more than one (1) year, or both, in the 27 discretion of the court. Such person shall not be permitted to 28 participate as a candidate in a public election in this Commonwealth until all costs and fines resulting from a 29 violation of this act SECTION have been paid in full. 30 19930H0966B3906
