- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, further providing for use of hearing impairment
- devices.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3314 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3314. Prohibiting use of hearing impairment devices.
- 9 (a) General rule.--No driver shall operate a vehicle while
- 10 wearing or using one or more headphones, earphones or any
- 11 similar device which the department by regulation determines
- 12 would impair the ability of the driver to hear traffic sounds.
- 13 (b) Exception. -- This section does not prohibit the use of
- 14 hearing aids or other devices for improving the hearing of the
- 15 driver nor does it prohibit the use of communication equipment

- 1 by the driver of a fire vehicle or by motorcycle operators
- 2 complying with section 3525 (relating to protective equipment
- 3 for motorcycle riders).
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 4
