AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled  
2 "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration  
3 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery  
4 Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of  
5 funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes  
6 from State and local taxation and making an appropriation,"  
7 providing for a transaction fee on certain tickets.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91),  
11 known as the State Lottery Law, is amended by adding a section  
12 to read:

13 Section 9.2. Transaction Fee on Certain Tickets.--(a) A fee  
14 of one dollar (\$1) is hereby imposed on the following:

15 (1) A transaction resulting in a receipt being given to a  
16 purchaser containing numbers selected by the purchaser, or at  
17 random, played or to be played in an out-of-State lottery.

18 (2) A transaction involving a contingent promise to pay,  
19 order to purchase or other record of an interest in an out-of-

1 State lottery.

2     (b) As used in this section, the term "transaction" means an  
3 arrangement for a receipt containing numbers played or to be  
4 played on one out-of-State lottery ticket or purchase of a  
5 contingent promise to pay, order to purchase or other record of  
6 an interest in one out-of-State lottery ticket.

7     Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
