4	hereby enacts as follows:	
5	Section 1. Short title.	
6	This act shall be known and may be cited as the State	
7	Automobile VEHICLE Sales Act.	<
8	Section 2. Definitions.	
9	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall	
10	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the	
11	context clearly indicates otherwise:	
12	"Department." The Department of General Services of the	
13	Commonwealth.	
14	"State automobile." An automobile VEHICLE." A VEHICLE owned	<
15	by the Commonwealth.	
16	Section 3. Sale of State automobiles VEHICLES.	<

1 Before selling State automobiles VEHICLES under section 2407 <of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The 2 3 Administrative Code of 1929, the department shall hold from sale 4 a minimum of 20 State automobiles VEHICLES that will be set <\_\_\_\_ aside for municipal purchases. Numbers and types of automobiles 5 <-----VEHICLES shall be determined by the department. Vehicles shall 6 <---be of the best quality. The purchase price shall be the average 7 8 price paid for similar automobiles VEHICLES at the most recent <---auction. Any automobile VEHICLE not purchased by a municipality 9 <----within 30 days of offer shall be subject to sale in accordance 10 with section 2407 of The Administrative Code of 1929. 11

12 Section 4. Effective date.

13 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
