AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for Federal prosecution
3 fingerprinting.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 9115. Federal prosecution fingerprinting.

9 Fingerprints of all persons arrested by Federal authorities
10 within this Commonwealth as a result of a joint investigation
11 with any Pennsylvania criminal justice agency shall be obtained
12 by the State criminal justice THAT agency and forwarded to, in a <—
13 manner and form provided by, the central repository. This
14 fingerprint card shall not be part of the criminal history
15 record of the individual being prosecuted and is to be used
16 solely for criminal investigative purposes. The information
17 entered shall be expunged under the provisions of section 9122

1 (relating to expungement).

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
