AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for Federal prosecution
- 3 fingerprinting.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 9115. Federal prosecution fingerprinting.
- 9 Fingerprints of all persons arrested by Federal authorities
- 10 within this Commonwealth as a result of a joint investigation
- 11 with any Pennsylvania criminal justice agency shall be obtained
- 12 by the State criminal justice THAT agency and forwarded to, in a <-
- 13 manner and form provided by, the central repository. This
- 14 fingerprint card shall not be part of the criminal history
- 15 record of the individual being prosecuted and is to be used
- 16 solely for criminal investigative purposes. The information
- 17 entered shall be expunded under the provisions of section 9122

- 1 (relating to expungement).
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
