- 2 The district attorney of each county shall maintain a
- 3 registry of each humane society and humane society agent within

- 3 A HUMANE SOCIETY POLICE OFFICER WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF A

- 7 SECTION 3. SEARCH WARRANTS.
- 8 NOTWITHSTANDING 18 PA.C.S. § 5511(1) (RELATING TO CRUELTY TO
- 9 ANIMALS) OR ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, THE
- 10 DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF ANY COUNTY SHALL REQUIRE THAT SEARCH
- 11 WARRANT APPLICATIONS FILED IN THE COUNTY IN CONNECTION WITH AN
- 12 ALLEGED VIOLATION OF THE CRUELTY TO ANIMALS LAWS HAVE THE
- 13 APPROVAL OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY PRIOR TO FILING. THE COURT OF
- 14 COMMON PLEAS OF A COUNTY SHALL ESTABLISH A PROCEDURE FOR
- 15 APPROVAL OF SEARCH WARRANT APPLICATIONS IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS
- 16 IF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY IS UNAVAILABLE.
- 17 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 18 THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
