- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for liability
- of golf courses for injuries sustained on adjacent highways.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 8311. Golf course liability for injuries sustained on
- 9 <u>adjacent highways.</u>
- 10 (a) General rule. -- There shall be a right of action against
- 11 a proprietor of a golf course for injuries sustained by persons
- 12 on highways adjacent to golf courses, who are struck by a golf
- 13 ball hit from a golf course.
- 14 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 15 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 16 <u>subsection:</u>
- 17 <u>"Golf course." Includes driving ranges.</u>
- 18 "Persons." Includes pedestrians, motorists and passengers of

- 1 <u>vehicles on adjacent highways</u>.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
