A RESOLUTION

- 1 Memorializing the President of the United States and Congress to appoint a national commission to investigate racism.
- 3 WHEREAS, Racism has been perpetuated in our society for many

- 5 WHEREAS, A closer examination of the impact of racism and why
- 6 it is still so prevalent in 1993 needs to be undertaken; and
- 7 WHEREAS, A national commission on the impact of racism could
- 8 hopefully benefit socioeconomically distressed communities;
- 9 therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 11 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize Congress and the
- 12 President of the United States to appoint a national commission
- 13 to investigate the impact of economic, social and governmental
- 14 policies and institutional racism on socioeconomically
- 15 distressed communities; and be it further

- 2 Pennsylvania.
