## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Requesting the Department of Education to study the need for alternative education programs.
- 3 WHEREAS, Many children in the schools today have multiple
- 4 chronic problems which impede learning and require alternative
- 5 teaching methodologies; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The need for alternative programs is even more
- 7 pronounced given the growing number of students who are expelled
- 8 for behaviors that would endanger others or themselves, the
- 9 nature of which makes the regular classroom assignment
- 10 inappropriate; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives request the
- 12 Department of Education to study the need for alternative
- 13 education programs which can accommodate the needs of all
- 14 students who require them; and be it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That the Department of Education make a report of
- 16 its findings and recommendations to the Governor and to the
- 17 House of Representatives not later than December 31, 1993.
