## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proclaiming the week of January 30 through February 4, 1994, as 2 "National Catholic Schools Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Strongly committed to the traditional tenets of an
- 4 education that both challenges the mind and builds the
- 5 character, Catholic Schools have played a vital role in
- 6 America's educational structure; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Unerringly dedicated to the belief that education
- 8 involves not only the child but also the family and the parish,
- 9 Catholic Schools have continually sought to offer opportunities
- 10 to our children that they might not otherwise know; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Catholic Schools have consistently offered quality
- 12 education to almost a quarter of a million Pennsylvania students
- 13 every year while saving State and local taxpayers more than \$1
- 14 billion dollars a year. Steeped in traditions that enhance the
- 15 building of self-esteem and self-confidence through a strong
- 16 recognition of self-worth, Catholic Schools continually strive
- 17 to offer academic opportunities that keep pace with an ever-

- 1 changing society. Ever challenged to accept the responsibilities
- 2 they will face as tomorrow's leaders, students in Catholic
- 3 Schools learn that effective leaders must first learn to serve
- 4 the needs of others; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Through the dedication of teaching staffs that are
- 6 truly committed to the values that have made Catholic Schools
- 7 such a unique educational opportunity, Pennsylvania's 900
- 8 Catholic Schools have achieved a dropout rate that is less than
- 9 3% a year, while seeing about 80% of their graduates go on to
- 10 college; and
- 11 WHEREAS, During the week of January 30 through February 4,
- 12 1994, Catholic Schools across this Commonwealth will celebrate
- 13 "National Catholic Schools Week" to promote the value of a
- 14 parochial school education; therefore be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives hereby proclaim
- 16 January 30 through February 4, 1994, as "National Catholic
- 17 Schools Week" in Pennsylvania, and encourage all Pennsylvanians
- 18 to recognize the importance of parochial schools in providing
- 19 our children with the solid values and academic skills they will
- 20 need in becoming responsible citizens of our Commonwealth.
