A RESOLUTION

- 1 Memorializing Congress to extend unemployment compensation to 2 certain persons participating in Federal job training.
- 3 WHEREAS, Foreign competition has caused the closure of many
- 4 steel plants within this Commonwealth, particularly in Mercer
- 5 County; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Under the Trade Readjustment Act the people who have
- 7 lost their jobs are eligible for Federal job training; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Many of these people are also eligible for
- 9 unemployment compensation, but these benefits are rapidly being
- 10 exhausted prior to the end of the job training courses;
- 11 therefore be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 13 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize Congress to extend
- 14 unemployment compensation benefits on an emergency basis to all
- 15 participants in TRADE READJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE OR NORTH AMERICAN <-
- 16 FREE TRADE AGREEMENT-RELATED Federal job training until after
- 17 the end of their job training courses and also to extend

- 1 benefits to those workers whose jobs have been lost as a result
- 2 of foreign competition; and be it further
- 3 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 4 the presiding officers of each house of Congress and to each
- 5 member of Congress from Pennsylvania.
