- 6 constituents are being turned away from VA hospitals for various
- 7 reasons, among them that there are not enough beds or the
- 8 hospitals are short-staffed; and
- 9 WHEREAS, There are reports that, upon careful review, there
- 10 are seemingly ample empty beds; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 12 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize the Congress of the
- 13 United States to give this situation careful review and fully
- 14 investigate the admissions practices of VA hospitals; and be it
