A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Requesting the Governor to act on House Bill No. 666, Printer's
2 No. 4363, of the 1994 session prior to November 30, 1994.

3 WHEREAS, The General Assembly has recognized that the 1990
4 amendments to the Federal Clean Air Act require Philadelphia,
5 Montgomery, Bucks, Chester and Delaware Counties to begin
6 selling reformulated fuel by January 1, 1995; and

7 WHEREAS, In 1991, Governor Robert P. Casey applied to the
8 Environmental Protection Agency to add an additional 28 counties
9 to the Reformulated Fuels Program; and

10 WHEREAS, The Senate of Pennsylvania sought to eliminate these
11 additional 28 counties from the program by amending House Bill
12 No. 666 of the 1994 session; and

13 WHEREAS, The Senate passed this amended legislation on
14 November 15, 1994, by a vote of 44-3; and

15 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives concurred in these

1 amendments on November 16, 1994, by a vote of 162-32; and

2 WHEREAS, The General Assembly has conveyed their commitment
3 to the citizens of this Commonwealth by passing this legislation
4 and forwarding it to the Governor for his action; and

5 WHEREAS, The Governor has ten days to sign, veto or do
6 nothing at all with House Bill No. 666; and

7 WHEREAS, The General Assembly seeks quicker action by the
8 Governor, urging him to act prior to November 30, 1994; and

9 WHEREAS, Under the Constitution of Pennsylvania, the General
10 Assembly will sine die at 12 midnight on November 30, 1994, and
11 will no longer have power to act on legislation from this
12 session; therefore be it

13 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the House of
14 Representatives urge Governor Robert P. Casey to act on House
15 Bill No. 666 prior to November 30, 1994; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be presented to the
17 Governor.
