1 2 3 4 5 6	Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for report of intention to adopt, for responsibilities of the Pennsylvania Adoption Cooperative Exchange (PACE), for consents necessary to adoption and for release of information in confidential reports.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 2531 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania
10	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
11	§ 2531. Report of intention to adopt.
12	(a) General ruleEvery person now having or hereafter
13	receiving or retaining custody or physical care of any child for
14	the purpose or with the intention of adopting a child under the
15	age of 18 years shall report to the court in which the petition
16	for adoption will be filed.
17	(b) ContentsThe report shall set forth:

18 (1) The circumstances surrounding the persons receiving19 or retaining custody or physical care of the child, including

the date upon which a preplacement investigation was
 concluded.

3 (2) The name, sex, racial background, age, date and
4 place of birth and religious affiliation of the child.

5

(3) The name and address of the intermediary.

6 (4) An itemized accounting of moneys and consideration7 paid or to be paid to the intermediary.

8 (5) Whether the parent or parents whose parental rights 9 are to be terminated have received counseling with respect to 10 the termination and the alternatives thereto. If so, the 11 report shall state the dates on which the counseling was 12 provided and the name and address of the counselor or agency 13 which provided the counseling.

14 (6) The name, address and signature of the person or 15 persons making the report. Immediately above the signature of 16 the person or persons intending to adopt the child shall 17 appear the following statement:

I acknowledge that I have been advised or know and understand that the natural parent may revoke the consent to the adoption of this child until a court has entered a decree terminating the parental rights and, unless a decree terminating parental rights has been entered, the natural parent may revoke the consent until a court enters the final adoption decree.

(7) A copy of the preplacement report prepared pursuant
to section 2530 (relating to home study and preplacement
report).

(8) FBI fingerprint cards for the persons receiving or
 retaining custody or physical care of the child.

30 <u>(c) Exception.--</u>When a person receives or retains custody or 19950H0116B0090 - 2 - 1 physical care of a child from an agency, the report shall set 2 forth only the name and address of the agency, the circumstances 3 surrounding such person receiving or retaining custody or 4 physical care of the child and a copy of the preplacement report 5 prepared pursuant to section 2530.

6 (d) Criminal records check.--Every person receiving or
7 retaining custody or physical care of any child for the purpose
8 or with the intention of adopting a child under 18 years of age
9 shall make a request for a report of Federal and State criminal
10 history to the Pennsylvania State Police. The Pennsylvania State
11 Police shall forward the criminal history information to the
12 court.

13 [(c)] (e) When report not required.--No report, fingerprints 14 or criminal records check shall be required when the child is 15 the child, grandchild, stepchild, brother or sister of the whole 16 or half blood, or niece or nephew by blood, marriage or adoption 17 of the person receiving or retaining custody or physical care. 18 Section 2. Section 2554 of Title 23 is amended by adding a 19 paragraph to read:

20 § 2554. Responsibilities of PACE.

21 PACE shall be responsible for the following:

23 (7) Requiring all agencies and intermediaries who

24 <u>facilitate adoptions to submit designated information</u>

25 regarding each finalized adoption. The required information

26 <u>should follow the guidelines outlined in Federal regulations</u>

27 and should also include information on adoption costs. The

28 information shall be forwarded to the department on a

29 <u>quarterly basis, and the department shall forward an annual</u>

30 adoption statistics report to the General Assembly.

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Section 3. Section 2711(d) of Title 23 is amended to read:
 § 2711. Consents necessary to adoption.

3 * * *

4 (d) Contents of consent.--

5 (1) The consent of a parent of an adoptee under 18 years 6 of age shall set forth the name, age and marital status of 7 the parent, the relationship of the consenter to the child, 8 the name of the other parent or parents of the child and the 9 following:

I hereby voluntarily and unconditionally consent tothe adoption of the above named child.

I understand that by signing this consent I indicate my intent to permanently give up all rights to this child.

I understand such child will be placed for adoption.
I understand I may revoke this consent to permanently
give up all rights to this child by placing the
revocation in writing and serving it <u>within 30 days</u> upon
the agency or adult to whom the child was relinquished.

I understand I may not revoke this consent after a court has entered a decree confirming this consent or otherwise terminating my parental rights to this child. Even if a decree has not been entered terminating my parental rights I may not revoke this consent after a decree of adoption of this child is entered.

I have read and understand the above and I am signing it as a free and voluntary act.

(2) The consent shall include the date and place of its
 execution and names and addresses and signatures of at least
 two persons who witnessed its execution and their
