AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, providing for a speed limit of 65 miles per hour on 3 rural interstate highways and on a certain portion of the Pennsylvania Turnpike; and further providing for speed timing 5 devices. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 3362 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: SECTION 1. 9	(a) General ruleExcept when a special hazard exists that
10	requires lower speed for compliance with section 3361 (relating
11	to driving vehicle at safe speed), the limits specified in this
12	[subsection] section or established under this subchapter shall
13	be maximum lawful speeds and no person shall drive a vehicle at
14	a speed in excess of the following maximum limits:
15	(1) 35 miles per hour in any urban district.
16	(1.1) 65 MILES PER HOUR FOR PASSENGER CARS, MOTORCYCLES <
17	AND TRUCKS HAVING A REGISTERED GROSS WEIGHT OF NOT MORE THAN

- 5 (a.1) Limit on certain highways. Notwithstanding subsection <
- 6 (a), the speed limit, for passenger cars only, on rural
- 7 <u>interstate highways and the east west portion of the</u>
- 8 Pennsylvania Turnpike outside of an urbanized area with a
- 9 population of 50,000 or more shall be 65 miles per hour.
- 10 (b) Posting of speed limit. -- No maximum speed limit
- 11 established under subsection (a)(1), (1.1) or (3) shall be
- 12 effective unless posted on fixed or variable official traffic-
- 13 control devices erected in accordance with regulations adopted
- 14 by the department which regulations shall require posting at the
- 15 beginning and end of each speed zone and at intervals not
- 16 greater than one-half mile.
- 17 (c) Penalty. -- Any person violating this section is guilty of
- 18 a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to
- 19 pay a fine of \$35. Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit
- 20 by more than five miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of
- 21 \$2 per mile for each mile in excess of five miles per hour over
- 22 the maximum speed limit.
- 23 § 6110. REGULATION OF TRAFFIC ON PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE.
- 24 (A) GENERAL RULE. -- THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE APPLY UPON
- 25 ANY TURNPIKE OR HIGHWAY UNDER THE SUPERVISION AND CONTROL OF THE
- 26 PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE COMMISSION UNLESS SPECIFICALLY MODIFIED BY
- 27 RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE COMMISSION WHICH SHALL
- 28 BECOME EFFECTIVE ONLY UPON PUBLICATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW. A
- 29 COPY OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS, SO LONG AS THEY ARE
- 30 EFFECTIVE, SHALL BE POSTED AT ALL ENTRANCES TO THE TURNPIKE OR

- 1 HIGHWAY FOR THE INSPECTION OF PERSONS USING THE TURNPIKE OR
- 2 HIGHWAY. THIS SECTION DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A
- 3 MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT GREATER THAN 55 MILES PER HOUR, EXCEPT FOR
- 4 PASSENGER CARS, MOTORCYCLES AND TRUCKS WITH A REGISTERED GROSS
- 5 WEIGHT OF 9,000 POUNDS OR LESS ON INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS OUTSIDE OF
- 6 AN URBANIZED AREA WITH A POPULATION OF 50,000 OR MORE.

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
- 9 SECTION 3. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 90 DAYS.
