4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
5	hereby enacts as follows:	
6	Section 1. Designation of "Commonwealth Day of Prayer AND	<
7	CELEBRATION OF RELIGIOUS FREEDOM."	
8	The first Thursday in May of each year shall be designated	
9	"Commonwealth Day of Prayer AND CELEBRATION OF RELIGIOUS	<
10	FREEDOM," and the Governor is urged to request its observance as	<
11	<del>a day</del> on which the people of this Commonwealth may turn to God	
12	in prayer and meditation AND ON WHICH FREEDOM OF RELIGION IN	<
13	THIS COMMONWEALTH MAY BE CELEBRATED.	
14	Section 2. Effective date.
