AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- 5 laws relating thereto, "prohibiting alcoholic beverages on
- 6 school property; and imposing a penalty.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 780.1. Alcoholic Beverages Prohibited on School</u>
- 13 Property.--(a) It shall be unlawful for any individual to
- 14 transport, possess or consume alcoholic beverages on property
- 15 owned or leased by school entities, including, but not limited
- 16 to, buildings, grounds and vehicles.
- 17 (b) Any person violating the provisions of subsection (a)
- 18 commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be

- 1 <u>sentenced to pay a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50) nor</u>
- 2 more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), and in default of
- 3 payment of the fine, shall undergo imprisonment for not more
- 4 than ten (10) days.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
