AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes, further providing for sexual abuse of children.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6312(c) and (d) of Title 18 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 8 § 6312. Sexual abuse of children.

- 10 (c) Dissemination of photographs and films.--[Any]
- 11 (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), any person who
- 12 knowingly sells, distributes, delivers, disseminates,
- transfers, displays or exhibits to others, or who possesses
- for the purpose of sale, distribution, delivery,
- dissemination, transfer, display or exhibition to others, any
- 16 book, magazine, pamphlet, slide, photograph, film, videotape

- or other material depicting a child under the age of 17 years
- 2 engaging in a prohibited sexual act or in the simulation of
- 3 such act is guilty of a felony of the third degree.
- 4 (2) Any person who, within 1,000 feet of the real
- 5 property on which is located a public, private or parochial
- 6 school, a church or a residence, knowingly sells,
- distributes, delivers, disseminates, transfers, displays or
- 8 <u>exhibits to others, or who possesses for the purpose of sale,</u>
- 9 <u>distribution</u>, <u>delivery</u>, <u>dissemination</u>, <u>transfer</u>, <u>display</u> or
- 10 <u>exhibition to others, any book, magazine, pamphlet, slide,</u>
- 11 <u>photograph, film, videotape or other material depicting a</u>
- child under the age of 17 years engaging in a prohibited
- 13 <u>sexual act or in the simulation of such act is guilty of a</u>
- 14 <u>felony of the second degree.</u>
- 15 (d) Possession of child pornography.--[Any]
- (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), any person who
- knowingly possesses or controls any book, magazine, pamphlet,
- 18 slide, photograph, film, videotape or other material
- 19 depicting a child under the age of 17 years engaging in a
- 20 prohibited sexual act or in the simulation of such act is
- 21 guilty of a felony of the third degree.
- 22 (2) Any person who, within 1,000 feet of the real
- 23 property on which is located a public, private or parochial
- 24 school, a church or a residence, knowingly possesses or
- 25 <u>controls any book, magazine, pamphlet, slide, photograph,</u>
- 26 <u>film, videotape or other material depicting a child under the</u>
- 27 age of 17 years engaging in a prohibited sexual act or in the
- 28 <u>simulation of such act is quilty of a felony of the second</u>
- 29 <u>degree</u>.
