## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for hearing impairment devices.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 3314 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 3314. Prohibiting use of hearing impairment devices.
- 8 (a) General rule. -- No driver shall operate a vehicle while
- 9 wearing or using one or more headphones, earphones or any
- 10 similar device which the department by regulation determines
- 11 would impair the ability of the driver to hear traffic sounds.
- 12 (b) Exception. -- This section does not prohibit the use of
- 13 hearing aids or other devices for improving the hearing of the
- 14 driver nor does it prohibit the use of communication equipment
- 15 [by the driver of a fire vehicle or] by motorcycle operators

- complying with section 3525 (relating to protective equipment 1
- 2 for motorcycle riders).
- 3 (c) Emergency vehicle exception. -- This section also does not
- prohibit the driver of any fire department vehicle or ambulance 4
- 5 or rescue vehicle from wearing or using a headphone, earphone or
- other similar device to monitor radio communication from a 6
- 7 dispatch center or other emergency unit while responding to an
- 8 emergency call.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 9
