# HOUSE BILL No. 750 Session of 1995

#### INTRODUCED BY PICCOLA (BY REQUEST), FEBRUARY 14, 1995

### REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT, FEBRUARY 14, 1995

#### AN ACT

Amending the act of May 29, 1956 (1955 P.L.1804, No.600), 1 2 entitled "An act providing for the establishment of police 3 pension funds or pension annuities in certain boroughs, towns 4 and townships, and the regulation and maintenance thereof; 5 providing for an actuary; continuance of existing funds or б transfer thereof to funds herein established; prescribing 7 rights of beneficiaries; contributions by members; providing for expenses of administration; continuation of existing 8 9 authority to provide annuity contracts; credit for military service; refunds; exempting allowances from judicial process; 10 and repealing certain acts," further providing for age 11 12 qualification for retirement from police force.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

14 hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of the act of May 29, 1956 (1955
P.L.1804, No.600), referred to as the Municipal Police Pension
Law, amended October 21, 1965 (P.L.643, No.317), is amended to
read:

Section 3. Each ordinance or resolution establishing a police pension fund shall prescribe a minimum period of total service in the aggregate of twenty-five years in the same borough, town or township [and shall fix the age of the members of the force at fifty-five years, or, if an actuarial study of

the cost shows that such reduction in age is feasible, may fix 1 the age of the members of the force at fifty years], after which 2 3 [they] members of the force may retire from active duty, and such members as are retired shall be subject to service, from 4 time to time, as a police reserve, in cases of riot, tumult or 5 preservation of the public peace until [unfitted] determined to 6 be unfit for such service, when they may be finally discharged 7 8 by reason of age or disability.

9 Section 2. All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar 10 as they are inconsistent with this act.

11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
