## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- 5 laws relating thereto," further providing for joint action by
- 6 a school board with other political subdivisions.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 521 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 10 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended to
- 11 read:
- 12 Section 521. Joint Action with Other Political
- 13 Subdivisions.--(a) Each board of school directors shall have
- 14 power to enter into agreements with other political
- 15 subdivisions, in accordance with existing laws, in making joint
- 16 purchases of materials, supplies, or equipment, and in
- 17 performing governmental powers, duties, and functions, and in
- 18 carrying into effect provisions of law relating to said

- 1 subjects, which are common to all such political subdivisions.
- 2 (b) Each board of school directors shall have the power to
- 3 <u>enter into agreements with other boards of school directors to</u>
- 4 form a pool for the purpose of purchasing group insurance
- 5 <u>covering health, hospitalization or medical service.</u>
- 6 Section 2. Nothing in this act shall be construed to affect
- 7 the terms of existing collective bargaining agreements.
- 8 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
