AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," further providing for school
6 holidays.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 1502(a) of the act of March 10, 1949
10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
11 amended March 28, 1994 (P.L.117, No.12), is amended to read:

12 Section 1502. Days Schools not to be Kept Open.-- (a)
13 Except as provided in subsection (b), no school shall be kept
14 open on any Saturday for the purpose of ordinary instruction,
15 except when Monday is fixed by the board of school directors as
16 the weekly holiday, or on Sunday, Memorial Day, Fourth of July,
17 [or], Christmas or New Year's Day nor shall any school be kept
18 open in any district during the time of holding the teachers'
19 institute for such district. Whenever Memorial day shall be on a

1 Sunday, the following Monday shall be a holiday.

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
