## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 5 laws relating thereto," further providing for school 6 holidays. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1502(a) of the act of March 10, 1949

- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
- 11 amended March 28, 1994 (P.L.117, No.12), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 1502. Days Schools not to be Kept Open. -- (a)
- Except as provided in subsection (b), no school shall be kept 13
- 14 open on any Saturday for the purpose of ordinary instruction,
- 15 except when Monday is fixed by the board of school directors as
- 16 the weekly holiday, or on Sunday, Memorial Day, Fourth of July,
- 17 [or], Christmas or New Year's Day nor shall any school be kept
- open in any district during the time of holding the teachers' 18
- institute for such district. Whenever Memorial day shall be on a 19

- 1 Sunday, the following Monday shall be a holiday.

- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
