AN ACT

- 1 Requiring all State-owned rest stop facilities to have a family
 2 restroom.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Family
- 7 Restroom Law.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "State-owned rest stop facility." A facility owned or
- 13 operated by the Commonwealth or operated by a concessionaire on
- 14 any portion of the Pennsylvania Turnpike or any portion of an
- 15 interstate highway within this Commonwealth.
- 16 Section 3. Restrooms.
- 17 Every State-owned rest stop facility shall provide a separate

- 1 family restroom for use of family members who assist a disabled
- 2 person in the restroom.
- 3 Section 4. Compliance.
- All State-owned rest stop facilities shall comply with this 4
- 5 act within three years of the effective date hereof.
- 6 Section 5. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately. 7
