AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for surrender of driver's
3 license.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1540(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1540. Surrender of license.

9 * * *

10 (b) Suspension, revocation or disqualification of operating
11 privilege.--Upon the suspension or revocation of the operating
12 privilege or the disqualification of the commercial operating
13 privilege of any person by the department, the department shall
14 forthwith notify the person in writing at the address of record
15 to surrender his driver's license to the department for the term
16 of suspension, revocation or disqualification. The suspension,
17 revocation or disqualification shall be effective upon a date
18 determined by the department or the date of surrender of the

1 license to the department if that date is subsequent to the
2 department's notice to surrender the license, whichever occurs
3 first. The license may be surrendered at any office of the
4 department or may be sent by certified mail, return receipt
5 requested, to the Bureau of Driver Licensing of the department
6 in Harrisburg. Upon surrender of the license, the department
7 shall issue a receipt showing the date that it received the
8 license.

9 * * *

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
