AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of August 21, 1953 (P.L.1273, No.361), entitled
 - "An act to regulate the business of private detectives,
- investigators and watch, guard, or patrol agencies, and the
- 4 licensing thereof in each county; providing penalties,"
- 5 providing for security guards.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of August 21, 1953 (P.L.1273, No.361),
- 9 known as The Private Detective Act of 1953, is amended by adding
- 10 a section to read:

- 11 Section 13.1. Security Guard. -- (a) A security guard who
- 12 holds a current and valid certification under the act of October
- 13 <u>10, 1974 (P.L.705, No.235), known as the "Lethal Weapons</u>
- 14 Training Act, " may carry a lethal weapon, including a firearm,
- 15 as an incidence to employment.
- 16 (b) A security guard employed by a holder of a license
- 17 certificate who has probable cause to believe that a person has
- 18 committed a crime on the premises where the guard is employed
- 19 may detain the person on the premises until a law enforcement

- 1 official takes the person into custody.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
