## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing sorrow and condolences regarding the June 25, 1996,
  - bombing at the United States Air Force housing compound near
- 3 Dhahran, Saudi Arabia, and requesting the Governor to order
- 4 the lowering of flags to half-staff.

- 1 WHEREAS, Shortly before 10:00 p.m. on June 25, 1996, a truck
- 2 loaded with explosives was driven by unknown persons onto a
- 3 Saudi air base near Dhahran, Saudi Arabia, and abandoned 35
- 4 yards from Building 131, a highrise apartment building housing
- 5 many of the United States Air Force personnel serving at the
- 6 base; and
- WHEREAS, Less than four minutes later, the truck exploded,
- 8 demolishing Building 131, killing 19 Americans, seriously
- 9 injuring 60 Americans, causing another 200 Americans minor
- 10 injuries and leaving a crater 35 feet deep and 80 feet wide; and
- 11 WHEREAS, While there are various theories explaining the
- 12 reason why this terroristic act occurred and identifying its
- 13 perpetrators, the event has sent a wave of sorrow and shock
- 14 throughout the international community which is allied to Saudi
- 15 Arabia; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Governor has ordered flags in this Commonwealth
- 17 to be lowered to half-staff; therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives express its
- 19 sorrow for the loss of life and for the injuries suffered as a
- 20 result of this bombing; and be it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That the condolences of the House of
- 22 Representatives be extended to the survivors of the blast and to
- 23 family members and other loved ones of those who did not survive
- 24 it.
