1 AS THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS. THE DEPARTMENT MAY 2 CONTINUE TO USE THE NAME DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS ON 3 STATIONERY OR ANY OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS UNTIL EXISTING SUPPLIES ARE 4 EXHAUSTED. THE DEPARTMENT MAY SUBSTITUTE THE TITLE DEPARTMENT OF 5 MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS ON ITS DOCUMENTS AND MATERIALS ON SUCH SCHEDULE AS IT 6 7 DEEMS APPROPRIATE. 8 SECTION 2. Certified copies of documents furnished without charge. * * * 11 12 (d) Certificates relating to release or discharge.--The 13 department, upon request, shall provide one certified, true copy 14 of each soldier's Certificate of Release or Discharge From 15 Active Duty to the Director of Veterans' Affairs of the county 16 where the soldier resided at the time of enlistment or to the 17 soldier or the soldier's representative free of any charge. 18 Section 2 3. The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs <----19 shall continue to use or recycle all forms, stationery, business 20 cards and other office supplies or materials which contain 21 references to its predecessor department until the existing 22 supplies and materials are depleted. 23 Section 3. Upon passage of legislation changing the name of <-24 the Department of Military Affairs to the Department of Military 25 and Veterans Affairs, the Adjutant General shall cause notice of 26 the same to be published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. 27 SECTION 4. REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE ADJUTANT GENERAL <-28 OR THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS HERETOFORE SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT AS REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF 29 30 MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS AND REFERENCES IN SUCH REGULATIONS - 2 -19950S0712B1747

TO THE DEPARTMENT OR THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS SHALL BE 1 DEEMED A REFERENCE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS 2 3 AFFAIRS. WITHIN 30 DAYS OF ENACTMENT OF THIS ACT, THE ADJUTANT GENERAL SHALL CAUSE NOTICE OF THE CHANGE OF THE NAME OF THE 4 DEPARTMENT TO BE PUBLISHED IN THE PENNSYLVANIA BULLETIN. 5 Section 4 5. The amendment of 51 Pa.C.S. § 9201 shall apply 6 <----to Certificates of Release or Discharge From Active Duty issued 7 on and after the effective date of this act. 8 9 SECTION 6. EXCEPT FOR THE AMENDMENT OF 51 PA.C.S. § 9201, <-----THIS ACT SHALL BE RETROACTIVE TO DECEMBER 21, 1995. 10 Section 5 7. This act shall take effect as follows: 11 <-----12 (1) The amendment of 51 Pa.C.S. § 9201 shall take effect 13 in 60 days. (2) Section 2 of this act shall take effect upon 14 <----15 publication of the notice under section 3 of this act. (3) (2) Section 4 5 of this act shall take effect in 60 16 <-----17 days. 18 (4) (3) The remainder of this act shall take effect <----19 immediately.
